During the summer, they operate a farm stand where they sell a variety of vegetables that are grown on site such as corn, tomatoes, zucchini, squash pepper and more.
2	Cupola Hollow Farm	1510 N Stone St. West Suffield CT 06093	Antique tractor will be out for display. Farm stand open from 10am-4pm: selling pies, jam, jellies, relish, pickles, etc.	Farm stand sells items such as pies, jam, jellies, relish and pickles. All products made using produce grown on site or another local farm.
3	Hastings Farm	472 Hill St. Suffield, CT 06078	Loop driveway; pass through to check out their calves.	Raise dairy and beef cows. Process their milk on site. Sell their beef and various dairy products such as milk, cheese, yogurt and ice cream in their shop.
4	Mac Farm	681 North St. Suffield, CT 06078	Farm equipment will be out for display.	Farm shop open daily from 9am-6pm every day except Sunday. Seasonal farm stand selling pumpkins, squash and grain; open September 15-November 15. Eggs for sale sign posted in front of farm when eggs are available.
5	Smyth's Trinity Farm	4 Oliver Rd. Enfield, CT 06082	Dry cows* out in pasture. Large open air barn that cows go in and out of all day. *Dry cows are in their last 40 days of pregnancy and are not milking. They are out pasturing all day.	Raise dairy cows. Process their milk on site. Farm shop open daily from 9am-6pm every day except Sunday selling: milk (whole, 1%, skim, chocolate, strawberry and coffee), yogurt, and butter. Offer home delivery in Enfield and surrounding towns. Also sells products from other local farms such as: local coffee roasted at Monsoon Roastery, maple syrup, honey, beef, and baked goods.
6	Syme Family Farm	72 Windsorville Rd. Broad Brook, CT 06016	Farm shop open from 10am-5pm: selling spring plants and vegetables. Walk around to check out the month old calf, cows, the wide array of flowers and Christmas trees- both to be sold in the coming seasons.	Cut flowers are sold June through October. Also offer a flower CSA; still a few spots open. Contact the farm directly for more information. Mums are sold in the Fall and Christmas tree sales start up after Thanksgiving. Raise dairy and meat cows as well.
7	Humming Grove Farm	73 Barber Hill Rd. Broad Brook, CT 06016	Road side table selling: gourmet mushrooms. Stop in to check out their Christmas trees and pods of wine cap stropharia mushrooms prior to harvesting.	The only farm in the country to grow gourmet mushroom wine cap stropharia. When in season, sell apples and tomatoes, Christmas trees, wreaths, handmade ornaments, beeswax candles, and local honey.
8	Hazelwood Morgan Farm	130 Trombley Rd. East Windsor, CT 06088	Horses out on pasture located across the street from 111 Trombley Rd. East Windsor, CT 06088 and behind the hay field.	Home where there was a reserved United States pair combined driving champion. Raise Morgan horses and board horses.
9	Stanton Equipment	105 South Main St. East Windsor, CT 06088	Farm equipment and tractors will be displayed.	Has 3 locations: East Windsor, Canaan and Plainfield. Sells new and used farm equipment and lawn and garden equipment.

10	Scotch Lane Farm	402 Main St South Windsor, CT 06074	A large pasture alongside the road with sheep and cows. You can pull in the driveway to get a better look at the farm animals.	Raise and sell UDSA inspected, all natural, pasture raised lamb, beef, and pork. Farm stand will reopen in September on Saturdays and Sundays 10am-4pm. Typically sells meat year round but currently sold out due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Will have lamb available by appointment only in mid-June. Follow Scotch Lane Farm on Facebook for updates.
11	Matson Farm	369 Savage Hill Road Berlin, CT 06037	Livestock exhibit by the road. Shop open from 9am-2pm: selling 2 lb. frozen packages of USDA ground beef.	Specializes in equine and livestock.
12	The Pickin' Patch	21 Nod Rd Avon, CT 06001	Farm store is open 10am-5pm selling: local and non-local produce, jams and jellies.	This farm has been operating since 1666. Farm stand open 10am-5pm every day selling what is in season. 30-40 varieties of vegetables are grown and sold on site during the summer months. Sell local fruit Seasonal produce During the Fall, they offer hay rides and sell pumpkins, apples, cider and fritters. Other items that can be purchased at the farm store depending on the season: locally grown fruit, baked goods and non- local produce. Hours change by the season; call the farm for hours of operation.
13	Brown's Harvest	1911 Pouquonock Ave. Windsor, CT 06095	Tractors and farm equipment will be out for display. Farm stand (honor system): selling asparagus and tomato plants.	Strawberry picking will be offered in a couple of weeks. Blueberry picking will start in July. The farm stand offerings change based on what is in season. Also sells products from other local farms such as: maple syrup and honey. A sunflower fest is held in August and Fall brings pumpkins, hay rides and a 6 acre corn maze. Hours change by the season; call the farm or check their website www.brownsharvest.com for hours of operation.

Farm stand (honor system): selling fresh eggs, maple syrup, assorted vegetable plants, annual plants and shrubs.	Hay, maple syrup, eggs are their staple items. Also sell organic pork compost, top soil and other items for landscaping needs.
15	Haywire Farm	6 Knollwood Ln West Granby, CT 06090	Horses will be out in the field grazing. Farm students and helpers will be grooming and riding horses or doing tricks throughout the day.	Riding lessons, horse management and equine healing work for people who are dealing with grief, social disorders, anxiety, etc.
16	Sweet Pea Cheese	151 East St North Granby, CT 06060	Loop driveway that brings you to the front of the store, the cow barn and you can even pass by Rosey, the cow (statue). If it's sunny out, you will see goats grazing on East Street. Farm shop open from 7am-630pm: selling goat and cow dairy products: various types of milk, cheese and yogurt.	Milking cows for 8 generations. Recently installed robotic milker in 2017. Started raising goats 12 years ago. Process their milk on site. Offer a variety of products they make from milk from their own goats and cows at their farm shop.
